"The prayer of Jabez"

Remember when the "Prayer of Jabez" swept through Christian circles and especially churches starting in 2000? Man, everybody was reading Dr. Bruce Wilkinson's book, "The prayer of Jabez." I think like lots of things in life there's a great motivation and in this case, to get extra blessings from God that sometimes those motivations go hay-wire. I'm sure many people read the book and used the concepts as shortcuts to getting something from God: being nice equals rewards from God preferably tangible rewards. That's what American Christians want, right? A fast track to more stuff. So, does obedience to God, no matter the motivation lead to extra blessings? From a Biblical perspective, in a word, no. But God does connect blessings of all kinds with obedience to Him. The Old Testament is filled with that specific dynamic. Read Deuteronomy 28:1-14; Psalm 91: 14-15; Isaiah 58; 131-14 if you don't believe me. If there is a correlation between His blessing us and our obedience to Him it behooves us to look more intenselv into the subject. Hey, I like blessings as much as the next guy! But maybe God defines blessing(s) differently than we do. And maybe just maybe the blessings He offers are SO much more incredible than we could ever think of or imagine! Like salvation. Or, because as children honoring parents is key to a blessed life in the areas of better relationships, less conflict, and more trust. Is that possible? What if a teenager decides to honor God's Word and avoid sexual immorality? What's the blessing? How about less complicated romantic relationships, fewer heartaches, and an absence if STD's! That's a no-brainer. What if people used God's Word as an instruction manual or a playbook? Don't you think that we'd end up with a better product and more success in whatever we're doing? God will and does bless us, according to His Word when we do what He asks. There are no shortcuts and He can't be manipulated. But He is a good father and wants us successful in this life as *He* defines success. James 1:17 says,

"Every good and perfect gift is from above, coming down from the Father of the heavenly lights, who does not change like shifting shadows" (NIV).
